



Masala has officially launched its taxi business! This venture now operates fully in compliance with city regulations, with both vehicles registered with the local government. We are also excited to introduce our first two drivers. Daniel (pictured on the right) and his wife began attending the Choolai church location in 2020, where they both came to faith in Christ. Daniel chose his new name and renounced his Hindu birth name as an outward expression of his commitment to Jesus, and together they both remain actively involved in ministry while supporting their family through this business. Surendhar (pictured on the left), who has been part of the Choolai ministry since first attending a youth event in 2012 while in the 11th grade, has grown into a humble and dependable leader, often arriving early to help prepare the church and regularly sharing the gospel in the surrounding slum communities. As Daniel and Surendhar provide for their families and give back to the church through a portion of their earnings, Masala looks ahead with plans to expand the program by adding another taxi, either to strengthen the Choolai fleet or to launch service at the Salaviel location with trusted church members who would also serve as drivers.
